This variable is the provider identification number. The first two digits indicate the state where the provider is located, using the SSA state codes; the middle two characters indicate the type of provider; and the last two digits are used as a counter for the number of providers within that state and type of provider (i.e., this is a unique but not necessarily sequential number).

Hospice (Fee-for-Service) The Hospice file contains claims submitted by Medicare hospice providers. Records are included in the file regardless of whether the beneficiary is enrolled in fee-for-service (FFS) Medicare or Medicare Advantage (Medicare managed care.) This file is based on information from the CMS form 1450 ( UB04 ).

Since 1996, HIPAA requires the adoption of a standard unique number for healthcare providers. The NPI Final Rule, issued in Jan 2004, has adopted the NPI number as that standard for healthcare provider identification. The NPI has replaced the UPIN (Unique Provider Identification Number) as the required identifier for all Medicare services, including health insurance claims.

NPI Number: The National Provider Identifier (NPI) is a unique identification number for covered health care providers. The NPI must be used in lieu of legacy provider identifiers in the HIPAA standards transactions.

Oct 18, 2019 · Since 2000, there has been substantial growth in Medicare payments for hospice services and the number of Medicare beneficiaries using hospice. This growth has been accompanied by an increase in the number of providers (primarily an increase in for-profit providers), reaching approximately 4,500 providers by 2017.

Jul 14, 2021 · Medicare pays the hospice provider for your care — no matter the amount. There's no deductible for hospice care. The only expenses you'll have to pay are Medicare Part A and B premiums, a copayment of up to \$5 for prescription drugs, and 5% of the Medicare-approved amount for inpatient respite care, if applicable.
